

Spring Residential Clean-Up Program

The 2010 Spring Residential Clean-Up Program will begin in **Section #4** and terminate in **Section #3**. All acceptable materials must be placed at the curb before 7:00 a.m. on the first clean-up day scheduled for a section, but not more than two days in advance. The contractor will cover each street **ONLY ONCE**. Therefore, it is very important that materials for pick-up are at the curb ready for collection on the **first day** for each section. Small, loose items will be picked up only if suitably placed in a wood, metal or other substantial container and weight of container and contents do not exceed 50 pounds.

All containers with debris in them will be picked up and disposed of by the scavenger unless clearly marked "**RETURN CONTAINER.**" By state law, doors on cabinets, appliances and refrigerators must be removed as a safety precaution. Boards, swings, monkey bars and similar items must be dismantled and cut to a maximum of four (4) feet in length. Equipment with, or containers of, gasoline, solvents, lacquer, acid alkalies, etc. should not be put out for collection. **Please report any unauthorized scavenging or scattering of debris to the Police Department at 464-1111. Please report to the Police Department any unauthorized dropping off of material.**

MATERIALS THAT WILL BE PICKED UP
